Heady and Fruity

Robe: sustained and intense

Bouquet: powerful and complex with a hint of red fruit and spices.

Aromas: start frank and dense, presence of red fruits with spicy notes, tannins are present and blended, the aroma is balanced and finishes on freshness.

Grape varietals: Syrah 45%, Carignan 25%, Grenache 25 %, Mourvedre 5%

Production: 42 Hl/Ha

Average age of vineyard: Syrah: 32 years, Carignan: 62 years, Grenache: 52 years.

Terroir: soil is limy clay 50 % rocky, exposed east/west. (the Terraces of La Liviniere):

Harvest: manual

Vinification and aging: selection is done in the vineyard and at the winery; grapes are transported to the winery in 1000 kg containers. Vinified with destemmed grapes, 12 day maceration. Aged in vats for about six months. Bottled in May 2019.
