Naked & Daring

‘Wine is Earth’s answer to the Sun’

Naked: only grapes

Daring: a beautiful wine with character lightly filtered before being bottled.

Robe: garnet, sustained.

Bouquet: frank and direct over garrigue notes (thyme, rosemary) and marmalade notes (figs, blackberries).

Aromas: starts frank and expressive. Structured and balanced. It coats the palate with a good density but without excess and finishes by blending softly.

Wine varietal: Mourvèdre.

Average age of vineyard: 30 years.

Terroir: soil is marley clay and lime with a few soft lime veins.

Vinification and aging: harvested by hand and vinified with destemmed grapes and indigenous yeast. Punch downs and pump overs from the start of fermentation. Temperature between 22 and 25°C during fermentation in vats. Assembled in November 2019; aged in vats.

Bottled in January 2020 at the winery.
