Nu & Culotté 2017 Naked & Daring

‘Wine is Earth’s answer to the Sun ‘

Naked: only grapes

Daring: a beautiful wine with character lightly filtered before being bottled.

Robe: garnet, sustained.

Bouquet: frank and direct over garrigue notes (thyme, rosemary) and marmalade notes (figs, blackberries).

Aromas: starts frank and expressive. Structured and balanced. It coats the palate with a good density but without excess and finishes by blending softly.

A beautiful bottle combining the restrained exuberance of the Syrah with the strength of the old Carignan.

Wine varietals: 50% Syrah and 50% Carignan.

Average age of vineyards: Syrah: 20 years; Carignan: 64 years.

Terroir: soil is marley clay and lime with a few soft lime veins (‘Les Soubergues’ and the first hills of La Livinière).

Vinification and aging: harvested by hand and vinified with destemmed grapes and indigenous yeast. Punch downs and pump overs from the start of fermentation. Temperature between 22 and 25°C during fermentation in vats. Assembled in November 2017; aged in vats.

This wine contains almost no sulfites.

Bottled in January 2018.
